

Projects are lumped into two categories – Military Construction and Facility Sustainment, Restoration, and Modernization (FSRM).

Project Selection Criteria:

Military Construction projects selected primarily on operational needs and ability to obligate funds quickly.

FSRM projects selected primarily on mission requirements, quality of life impact, national Environmental Policy Act documentation status, and acquisition strategy with a focus on ability to execute quickly. In addition, the department included repair and modernization projects for facilities that are currently vacant, which potentially could be occupied by troops returning from Iraq or Afghanistan.
